2. Nomination of Commonwealth Trustee – Dr. Kellyn Hodges

<u>Recommendation</u>: Having received notice that Dr. Kellyn Hodges has been appointed by Governor Tom Wolf, to the Board of Trustees of Temple University – Of The Commonwealth System of Higher Education, the Governance and Nominating Committee (11/29/2022), recommend that the Board of Trustees confirm the appointment of Dr. Hodges for a term effective immediately, and continuing through October 14, 2025, as described in Agenda Reference 2.

9. <u>Vendor Pad/12th Street Outdoor Dining Area Amendment #1 (Construction)</u>
